

Bracegirdle, Michael - Tenor

Biography



Winner of the Emmy Destinn Award for Young Singers and a graduate of Durham University, Michael Bracegirdle previously enjoyed a successful career as a Finance Director in the UK. In 2003 he gave up his business career to further his vocal studies at the Royal Northern College of Music.

Jis **recent engagements** include **Jamie**(*Brothers*) with the Malmö Opera Orchestra / Icelandic Opera at The Copenhagen Opera Festival and as soloist with Sønderjyllands Symfoniorkester in their 2024 New Year's Concert series.

Michael's operatic career has taken him from the UK and mainland Europe to the Far East and the USA, working with companies including The Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, English National Opera, The Danish Royal Opera, Welsh National Opera, The Israeli Opera, Opera Holland Park, Scottish Opera, English Touring Opera, Longborough Festival Opera, Mid Wales Opera, Theater Erfurt, Opéra de Rennes, Opéra de Limoges, and Opéra de Reims.

Michael Bracegirdle's passionate and determined Siegmund was another outstanding contribution, navigating sensitively between the assured conviction of a proven hero, and the tragic uncertainty of a man abandoned by a father he never truly knew, constantly finding himself embroiled in quarrels he can neither justify nor solve. From an authoritative and mellifluous start, Bracegirdle went on to deliver a superb Siegmund full of integrity and honour. Bracegirdle's lyrical tenor was well up to the challenge of the role; Winterstürme came across beautifully as Bracegirdle settled into its phrasing, and his cries of *Wälse!* had a fantastic sense of urgency.
