

# McClelland, Louise - Soprano

## **Biography**



Louise McClelland Jacobsen is a Danish/New Zealand soprano born in 1997 and based in Copenhagen. She graduated her master's degree with honors in summer 2023 from The Royal Danish Opera Academy. Prior to this, she studied at The Royal Danish Academy of Music and at Hochschule für Musik und Theater Hamburg.

Her soloist debut with The Danish National Symphony Orchestra took place in 2018, she sang there again in 2024 and she will be performing with them again later this year.

Her stage debut at The Royal Danish Theatre (Opera House) was as **5.Magd** in Strauss' *Elektra* in March 2023. Following that, she sang the role of the **High Priestess** in Verdi's *Aida*, the roles of **Amante**, **Suor Genovieffa**, **Lauretta** in Puccini's *Il Trittico*, **Pamina** in Mozart's *Die Zauberflöte* and **Aase** in Heise's *Drot og Marsk*.

She also worked with several **orchestras and ensembles such as** Concerto Copenhagen, Ensemble Storstrøm, The Royal Danish Orchestra, Jönköping's Sinfonietta, Copenhagen Philharmonic, Aalborg Symphony, Ensemble MidtVest, ensemble Theatre of Voices and The Spanish Symphony Orchestra among others.

She has been granted several **awards and scholarships**, such as the Carl Nielsen and Anne Marie Carl-Nielsens Talent Award and the Léonie Sonnings Talent Prize. In 2024, she was announced *Talent of the Year* for DR P2 (the Danish Broadcasting Corporation's classical music station).

Her **repertoire embraces** an enormous range from early music to the latest modern repertoire, from lieder to oratorios to opera. She is looking forward to premiering new compositions this year, both in Denmark and abroad.

Louise enjoys **chamber music** Trio Doré, with hornist, Lasse Mauritzen, and harpist, Zachary Hatcher. After winning the first Langgaard Competition in Denmark in 2021, she completed her first recording (DaCapo Records) of Rued Langgaard's songs with pianist Kristian Riisager. The album is 'Album of the Week' (8, 2024) on DR P2.

The vast majority of the songs here are world-premiere recordings and represent a fifth of the total Langgaard composed. Performed with sensitivity and intelligence by soprano Louise McClelland Jacobsen and pianist Kristian Riisager, the settings feature adaptations from Russia and Ukraine alongside Danish texts, including by Langgaard himself.
