

Hwang, Tae Jeong - Bass

Biography



Tae Jeong Hwang, a Korean bass, first pursued studies in lyric singing at Kyeongwon University before honing his abilities in Russia under the renowned baritone G. Zastavny at the Saint-Petersburg State Conservatory of Rimsky-Korsakov. He continued to refine his skills in Italy, studying with the acclaimed bass B. Giaiotti. Along his academic journey, he achieved **recognition in numerous international competitions**.

Making his debut in 2006 in Italy, Hwang has graced illustrious stages, portraying notable roles such as **Colline** in *La Boheme*, **Ramfis** in *Aida*, **Basilio** in *Il Barbiere di Siviglia*, and **Zaccaria** in *Nabucco*.

From 2018 onward, he has been an integral chorus member at The Royal Danish Theatre, while also highlighting his prowess as a soloist. Hwang particularly distinguished himself as **Dr. Grenvil** in *La Traviata* and **Alidoro** in *La Cenerentola*.
